

## **Education Committee, 2015 Update**

**Below is a summary of the bills Citizens for 1 followed in the Louisiana legislature and the results**

### **HB 113, 373 and 166 House Education OPPOSED Common Core Compromise Reached**

Legislators and Superintendent John White reached a compromise on a plan to move forward with Louisiana student standards and tests. All three bills mentioned were amended to reflect the various items in the compromise. The Governor signed the bills that related to that compromise. Read details in Educate Now!

### **House Bill 21: House Education Committee – OPPOSED Was involuntarily deferred**

HB 21 would not allow BESE to authorize charter schools where a local school board has denied a charter to that school.

### **House Bill 600 House and Governmental Affairs – OPPOSED Was pulled when the CCSS compromise was reached**

HB600 would place most actions of BESE and the Department of Education (as well as other state agencies) under the governance of the Administrative Procedures Act.
